- message to the Board of Trustees: let the Campus help you to do what you said you would do:
- develop a collaboration with Second Harvest Food Bank to bring access to free food for students to pick up.
- look into the college application to see if there can be a place for students to check from the list to donate ie. \$1.00 for support of students in need (such as food). Also can look to faculty/staff as well. This is not supporting programs - but students basic needs!
