- 1. Overview of Progress (brief highlights) 3 domains
- 2. Showcase completed/successful programs/activities from the Goals and Objectives (highlight one or two to be determined)
 - · A Basic Skills Project?
 - Academic Support Services (one of the programs)
 - Umoja
 - · STEM Jo Wu with NASA (check with Karen Rose) & check with Rolando
- Possibly identify change in direction and/or additions (this would be in overview)
- 4. Connect each of the above with some data
- Note: Differences in student success may not show up while students are at FC.
 It may be several years down the line.
- 6. <u>Identify Areas of Concern</u>
 - Still need to address the Achievement Gap (especially in target populations)
 - Still need much work to support students who are not college-ready when arriving at FC.
 - · College-ready students do well at FC
- 7. What we do Know!
 - Best one of the best indicators of student success is the person in front of the classroom (or the first classified at the counter)
 - Need to focus on staff development and effective teaching practices for diverse learners. KEY
 - Need to provide students with clear information and support before they arrive and throughout their time at FC
 - Effective way to do this is through an effective Campus
 Website (ID our recommendation last January)
 - A Comprehensive First Year Experience Program **KEY**
