1. **Facilities - Location - Signage** - End of Meeting: We have a comprehensive recommendation for all signage on campus. Resubmit our Recommendation (Revised)

- **Need to go back and retrieve our original recommendations for signage back in 2008 and see how far the campus can progressed. Make additional recommendations and resubmit.**
- Need banners to come back in the Quad to identify specific information. We had them before the renovation of the 400 building. They need to be kept up-to-date (which was a problem and always hung properly).
 - Possible get the Graphic Arts Dept./Print Shop to have this as a student project.
 - Have them ready for Fall.
- We need to look at having an electronic Marquee on Chapman Ave.
- Check into the College and District Marketing Plans: do not see advertising in the media as other campuses.
- Look into "naming" building. Even with people who donate for the signage and/or renovations.
- We can do much in small ways that do not necessarily come out of general funds to help students navigate the campus. Let's get something in motion to be ready for Fall.

- Maybe get business to help sponsor a building in putting up signage: Pearson Co. for the Math building.

- Check the Master Plan to see how signage was addressed and if they took in our original recommendations.

Publicity - Access

- Inside campus. Need to have information for the students. Need to work closely with the A.S.
- Student Information Walls: Need information areas that are rain/wind protected so clubs and others can make announcements. Make signs easy to read and keep the information walls up-to-date. Possible areas for the new Student Information Walls: 200 building, Library (between the 500 & Library), 1200 building (if there is green space designed outside the Health Center with seating, as well as along the east side of the 400 building the west side of the 1200 building next to the Health Center would be a good location. This would give the Health Center needed exposure as well. The A.S. will look over the campus and come to the next meeting with recommendations for the Student Information Walls
- 1400 - need signage and possible seating in the green belt in front.
- 2000 need to look at as well.
- Lab School needs signage
- Parking Signs into the Parking Lots identifying what access to building are from those lots.
